Objectives

The aim of the rally is to provide car enthusiasts from different countries with an opportunity to **discover places of interest** in Brittany and Maine, as well as participating in a public presentation of cars at a chosen site.

For the year 2010, the Rally will take place May 28th to 31st.

AC Cars and Marauder will be the « marques of honour ».

Total mileage is approximately 250 miles avoiding heavy traffic roads and town centres.

Admission

The Rally is limited to 150 cars in order to maintain a friendly atmosphere. The selection is based on age and rarity. Only car types produced before 1962 are accepted, unless they are of exceptional historic or mechanical interest. Applications for «specials» will be examined individually.

The Fougères Rally tends to be oversubscribed and selected cars may have to be accepted on a « first come, first served » basis. Late applicants will be refunded by the APPF.

Those who send a copy of the FIVA Identity Card of their vehicle – or of a DVLA Vehicle Registration document (Britain) - with the returned application form will be given priority. A FIVA ID Card can be obtained from your national federation belonging to FIVA. See list and procedure on www.fiva.org

The 2010 Rally will maintain the tradition of mixing groups of veteran, vintage, PV and classic cars, both popular and exclusive. Participants may choose to attend only part of the four-day programme, by indicating their selection of events on the application form.

Hotels

The APPF has pre-booked a sufficient amount of rooms in gîtes, hotels and château-hotels at convenient locations. A suggested choice may be indicated on the application document. This can be modified by participants when filling in forms. We will try to satisfy all requirements.

Payments

A fixed **non-refundable organisers' fee** of £105 (approx. 110 euros) per car is requested for a participant attending more than one day. The fee for a one-day participation is £33 (approx. 35 euros). It includes all visits and musical features, catalogue, rally plaque, etc.

This fee and most meals and bus services must be paid in advance by cheque made out to A.P.P.F. and sent with the application form (see § 5). The APPF's UK account facilitates payment by British cheques for British entrants.

Hotel expenses and the « open » meal on Sunday are paid directly to the suppliers.

Any cancellation after May 1st, 2010 may have to be paid in full.

Some hotels require advance payment or credit card details. They are indicated on the application form.

Miscellaneous

To help in producing the free catalogue, we ask all participants to send a **photograph** of their car with the application document (returned on arrival). Good quality electronic pictures are accepted.

French road regulations (including car insurance) must be respected. Following FIVA and FFVE recommendations, the APPF will check that each participant possesses proper and up-to-date papers.

A road-book will be provided and the motorcycle section of the APPF will be posted at key junctions.
