We have 18 double rooms and 10 single rooms reserved until **February 2nd 2012**.

We have arranged special prices for your stay,

Double Room, Euro 402 Single Room, Euro 209.25 Included in the price are, room, breakfast, dinner / buffet in the evening (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) and taxes.

There are no further charges. If you wish to stay longer, extra nights (dinner excluded) will cost you Euro 74 for a double room or Euro 39.75 for a single room. There is much to see with the cities of Breda and Hertogenbosch close by, as is the Belgian border. The hotel is situated well away from the road, in a wooded area. There is a sauna and fitness centre and plenty of space for trailers, the three wheelers can park in front of the terrace. So after your day out we can all relax with a pint in hand and car close by.
