

## **TREASURER'S REPORT 2015**

This written report supplements the detailed verbal report that I shall give to members at the AGM in Malvern in September, and is also covered by the Report of the Committee and Financial Statements for the Year Ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2014, as included for members in the Bulletin. It should be noted that the CCM has decided to change the financial year end to March 31<sup>st</sup> each year, so for 2014/15 it is exceptionally a 10 month year. The CCM also decided, against the advice of the Treasurer and the Club's accountants, to pro-rata some the membership income received each year into the following year. For both these reasons the accounts presented for 2014/15 are unusual compared to other years.

It has been a successful year for the Club financially in 2014/15. We have a clean bill of health on the accounts from Boyd's accountants, who act as the Independent Examiners. Income has increased over the previous year and expenses reduced, resulting in a small increase in the operating profit before the addition of the contribution from Mogspares. Current assets are slightly reduced at £268K, but the Club remains in a strong financial position.

The fall in Mogspares profit is much reduced this year compared to previous years, providing a contribution to Club income of £9,900.00. This bodes well for the future.

Sadly the difficulties in running a Club with a CCM of over 40 members who attend quarterly meetings in varying and changing numbers has continued to cause frustrations and difficulties this year. Despite including many honourable and well-meaning members it remains, in my opinion, a dysfunctional and ineffective way of running the Club. For this reason I will not be standing for re-election as Treasurer of the Club at the AGM, but am grateful for the support of members whilst I have held this post, which has been a privilege to undertake.

The Club remains in good financial health with an increasing membership.
