**SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**

1. The event is to be held in conjunction with the Vintage Sports Car Club Limited on Saturday 12th August 2017 at Mallory Park Circuit in Leicestershire.

2. This “Restricted” meeting meeting will be held under the National Sporting Code and Standing Regulations of the ACU, and these Supplementary Regulations, together with any Final Instructions subsequently issued or Official Announcements made.

3. Eligibility - only fully paid up members of the Morgan Three wheeler Club will be allowed to compete. You must be the holder of a current racing licence from the ACU or SACU and quote the number on the entry form. Competitors who are on the ACU Stop List because of a concussion injury or suspended from ACU competition will not be allowed to compete. Morgans must conform to the MTWC Sporting Formula or agreed exceptions.

4. Events and times are as specified in the meeting regulations. The Morgan Three Wheeler Race will comprise three classes of ACU NSC Category 1 Group B3 Morgans – Standard, Touring Modified and Racing Classes, as defined by the MTWC Sporting Formula and three classes of ACU NSC Category 2 Group D Morgans - Standard, Touring Modified and Track Modified as defined by the MTWC Sporting Formula for New 5 Speeder Morgans.

6. Technical Control – At the discretion of the Clerk of the Course and Chief Technical Official, Technical control may be available from 6.30 p.m. on the evening prior to the meeting. Also at 7.30 a.m. on the day of racing. These times will be published in the Technical Control Bay. Riders are required to produce their machine together with their Technical Control Card to the Technical Official. Competitors are required to produce their machine and clothing, helmet, boots, gloves and identification disc for checking by the technical officials. Competitors must wear their protective clothing, helmet, boots, gloves, identification disc and novice jacket (if applicable) when being checked by the Technical Official. The Chief Technical Official may refuse to examine any machine that is in a dirty condition. Technical Control stickers from previous events must be removed before the machine and helmet are presented for inspection.

All drivers and passengers must sign on after technical control and produce a valid ACU/SACU competition licence.

7. Mallory Park is located at Kirkby Mallory in Leicestershire and the Full Circuit of 1.39 miles will be used. Racing will be in a clockwise direction.

8. Practice – there will be one practice session of 10 minutes duration minimum.  
If you do not complete this you may start the race only at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

9. Start and finish of the races – a red light will be displayed for up to 5 seconds. The red light will go out to start the race, or alternatively the National flag will be lowered. Finish will be at the chequered flag as per ACU Standing Regulations. The race will be of 15 minutes duration.

10. **Entries close on Friday 28th July 2017.** Please forward the completed entry form and the entry fee of £175 per vehicle to the Secretary of the meeting at the above address as a matter of urgency. Please make cheques payable to 'MTWC - Sporting'.

Withdrawal of Entry and Refunds

- a. cancellation prior to closing date - Full refund
- b. cancellation after closing date - No refund

11. Change of machine/rider/passenger – no change will be permitted unless received in writing to the Clerk of the Course before the start of practice. Only the holder of a current entrants licence can request a change after this time. A change of machine, rider OR passenger may be permitted but not more than one of these. Ballast may be carried in lieu of a passenger with the permission of the Competition Secretary and the ACU.

12. Each eligible competitor will score points towards the Morgan Three Wheeler Club Challenge Series for which there will be a presentation at the end of the season.

13. The Morgan Three Wheeler Club undertakes to insure each rider and passenger, indemnifying him or her against any third party claims made arising out of the races or official practice, excluding claims by other riders or passengers, entrant, sponsor or mechanic.

14. The consumption of alcohol and banned substances by competitors or officials during the meeting is forbidden.

15. The maximum permitted noise level will be 105dBa for all machines.

16. Treaded tyres complying with the Morgan Sporting Formulas must be used.

17. Notwithstanding your signature and acceptance of the General Declaration on the entry form, the following indemnity must be accepted and signed before you will be permitted to compete at the meeting.

18. For the safety of riders, passengers and spectators **Animals are not permitted.**
