- As in past years, traditional food, real ale and locally made cider and other drinks will be available throughout the day at very reasonable costs.
  - Food is being provided by Community Group members and volunteers.
- The day will see various activities, acts and music on a stage area and in the Arena.

The emphasis for the day is on tradition and rural life, now and in times past. If you are able and/or inclined to enter into the spirit of the day with us, please feel free to dress up in the style of the 1950s!

Hallow Playing Field is located in the centre of Hallow (WR2 6PP). Follow sign for Parish Hall. If approaching from the north, turn right into the drive just after The Crown Inn and from the south (Worcester) turn left just after the Village Green and before the Crown. There will be a steward at the turning who will be able to direct you.
