

1. Objects

- 1.1. The object of this Touring Group is to promote the use and enjoyment of Morgan Three Wheelers by arranging and participating in non-competitive touring events in the UK and elsewhere.

2. Group Membership

- 2.1. All members of the Morgan Three Wheeler Club are eligible to take part in Touring Group events.

3. Group Organiser

- 3.1. The Group Organiser will organize touring events for Club members and will liaise with and, where appropriate, assist other Club members who are organizing similar events.
- 3.2. The Group Organiser will be elected by the Club members at the AGM each year and will sit on the Club Central Committee.
- 3.3. The Group Organiser will comply with the Club Officers' Guidelines.

4. Publicity and Entries

- 4.1. All Touring Group events will be advertised in advance in the Club Bulletin and, where possible, via the Club website and other means of communication.
- 4.2. Unless there are exceptional circumstances, to be agreed with the Club Committee, every Touring Group event shall be open to all Club members.
- 4.3. Except by prior agreement, entrants in Touring Group events will take part in a Morgan three-wheeler.
- 4.4. When there is a limit to the number of participants who can be accommodated on an event, places shall be allocated to members on a first come-first served basis.

5. Finance

- 5.1. Where possible, Touring Group activities shall be self-financing.
- 5.2. If the expenditure on an event may be greater than the income it generates, organisers may request the Committee to underwrite some or all of the cost. If this is agreed, the CCM will specify a maximum amount of Club funds which may be paid to refund the organiser when final costs are known. The organiser shall provide full accounts detailing costs and income and the Treasurer will arrange payment from whichever Club account the CCM has decided.
- 5.3. If significant initial outlay is required in order to arrange an event, organisers may request that the Club Committee agree to provide Club funds in advance and the Treasurer will make payments as necessary. The organiser will repay this sum when income has been received unless the Committee has agreed otherwise, as detailed in 5.2 above.
- 5.4. The Group Organiser or his/her delegated representative shall not enter into any contractual agreement if this might result in legal or financial obligation to the Club, without the prior approval of the Treasurer.

6. Insurance

- 6.1. Touring Group events will be covered by the Club insurance, within the limits of the policy and provided that the criteria in the Definition of a Club Event or Activity have been met.
- 6.2. Cover for overseas events will normally apply except in the USA, although the latest insurance documents should be reviewed to confirm this.
