

## **Secretary's Report 2020**

It has obviously been very much a year of two halves.

As Charles has noted in his report, it started with a very successful AGM at a new venue which proved to be very popular.

The November and February CCM's were held in the normal manner, the only difference being that as an experiment rather than holding the November meeting at the same venue as the Sporting Section AGM and dinner, which is expensive and which has in past years been relatively poorly attended, it was instead held at the usual venue for Committee meetings in King's Sutton. Whereas 13 attended the 2018 meeting, 19 attended the 2019 meeting, so to that extent the experiment was successful. No decision has yet been taken regarding this year's November meeting, but at present it would seem unlikely that it can take place in the conventional manner in any event.

Following the February meeting, Covid struck, and the April meeting was cancelled altogether along with much else. The July meeting took place by Zoom, which worked quite surprisingly well, and will probably be the model for future meetings for the time being until circumstances change.

As set out in the Chairman's and the other Club Officers' reports, despite the lock down and the resulting cancellation of events, nevertheless there have been successes, and in particular while we wait for circumstances to change so that we can again meet and use our Morgans as normal, we can look forward to the publication of Nev Lear's new history of the Club.
