#### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The event is to be held at Curborough Sprint Course near Litchfield in Staffordshire on **Sunday June 11th, 2023**

2. This "Restricted" status meeting will be held under the National Sporting Code of the ACU and Standing

Regulations for Sprints, and these Supplementary Regulations, together with any Final Instructions subsequently issued or Official Announcements made.

3. Eligibility - only fully paid up members of the Morgan Three Wheeler Club, VMCC, Vincent HRD Owners Club, BSSC and The Classic 50 Club and other invited clubs will be allowed to compete. You must be the holder of a current racing Licence from the ACU or SACU and quote the number on the entry form. A one day Licence will be available to UK residents under the age of 70 years only. Morgan's must conform to the MTWC Sporting Formula or agreed exceptions. Official start time of the event is 0900Hrs

4. Events and time s are as specified in the Final Instructions. The Morgan Three-Wheeler Sprint will comprise three classes of ACU NSC Category I Group BJ Morgan's - Standard, Touring Modified and Racing Class, as defined by the MTWC Sporting Formula and three classes of ACU NSC Category 2 Group D Morgan's - Standard, Touring Modified and Track Modified as defined by the MTWC Sporting Formula for New 5 Speeder Morgan's.

6. Technical Control -At the discretion of the Clerk of the Course and Chief Technical Official, Technical control may be available from 6.30 p.m. on the evening prior to the meeting. Also at 7.30 a.m. on the day of racing. These times will be published in the Technical Control Bay. Riders are required to produce their machine together with their Technical Control Card to the Technical Official. All riders and passengers must wear their protective clothing, helmet, boots gloves, identification disc and novice jacket (if applicable) when being checked by the Technical Official. The Chief Technical Official may refuse to examine any machine that is in a dirty condition. Technical Control stickers from previous events must be removed before the machine and helmet are presented for inspection.

7. Curborough is a twisty sprint course of 900 yards (1 lap). Competitors run individually against the clock. Return to the paddock as directed by the officials.

8. Practice - there will be one practice run and at least three timed runs.

9. Start will be by lights and completion at the checkered board.

**Entries close on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May 2022.** Please forward the completed entry form and the entry fee of **£90.00 per machine** to the Secretary of the meeting at the above address. **Please make cheques payable to MTWC – Sporting and enclose a self-addressed Envelope.**

Withdrawal of Entry and Refunds

- a. cancellation prior to closing date - Full refund
- b. cancellation after closing date - No refund.

10. Change of machine/ride passenger - no change will be permitted unless received in writing to the Clerk of the Course before the start of practice. Only the holder of a current entrants License can request a change of rider. A change of machine, rider OR passenger may be permitted but not more than one of these. Ballast may be carried in lieu of a passenger with the permission of the Comp Sec and the ACU.

**Vehicles maybe used for dual drives at this event and will be charged at £30 per additional driver.**

**An entry form must be completed by each proposed driver.**

11. The Morgan Three Wheeler Club undertakes to insure each rider and passenger, indemnifying him or her against any third party claims made arising out of the races or official practice, excluding claims by other riders or passengers, entrant, sponsor or mechanic.

12. The consumption of alcohol or intake of banned substances by competitors or officials during the meeting is forbidden.

13. The maximum permitted noise level will be 105dB for all machines.

14. Treaded tyres complying with the MTWC Sporting Formula must be used.

16. Each eligible competitor will score points towards The Morgan Three-Wheeler Club Challenge Series & The MTWC Sprint & Hillclimb series for which there will be presentation at the end of the season.

17. For the safety of riders, passengers and spectators. Animals **are not permitted** at the meeting.
