

New items this month

The late type track rod end shouldered bolts (MSR413/1 provisional price £18.05 ex VAT), from 1937 on I believe, are now available. As these are on many more F types than twins, they are being stocked by Roger Comber. The bronze cones were announced last month. The springs for these are now on order and should be available shortly. No-one has responded so far to our request for any demand for the later type of track rod end bodies so we have no plans to progress those at the moment.

A knowledgeable member pointed out that we should not be supplying 2BA countersunk screws with the bevel box bearing retaining rings as they should be 3/16" BSF. The difference is miniscule (0.001" pitch error) but Bob Derricott has managed to secure a quantity of 3/16" BSF countersunk screws, sufficient for our current stock of rings. I am pleased to know that someone reads what I write and thank you for the "heads up". As we say here, "He who never made a mistake never made owt!"

Items newly back in stock

Matchless rocker arm thrust washers (RE.200). Originally a steel pressing, our supplier has done a great job in producing these thin L-section washers as CNC turned parts. Order from Roger Orford.

Following machining of a new batch of housings and the numerous supplementary parts, contact breaker kits are available for JAP (MS11491/2) from Chuck Berry and for Matchless (RE91) from Roger Orford. These are £97.51 + VAT for the complete kit, to be assembled by the owner.

Coming soon

3-speeder clutch driving plates / starter ring gears are in manufacture. We expect to place orders soon for 3-speeder tailshafts (not available from us for a long time), and 2-speeder sliding dogs (new to Mogspares). Early orders for any of these new items would be much appreciated.

Some of you will have NOS Burman wide ratio gear sets as used in all the pre-war F types but are missing the 2nd/3rd sliding pinion. We are looking into having a small batch of these made. It would be extremely useful if you let us know if you are interested in obtaining one of these.
