

After a busy period for deliveries in November there is not much to report this month with many suppliers having a long Christmas break. I reported in the January Bulletin on the number of new items that are in progress and due to be in stock in the next month or so. We have yet to organize the machining of the speedo drive brackets but have had a few expressions of interest in those so we will have to get on with ordering the special drive nuts and cable fittings to go with these.

We have some F type silencers and exhaust pipes in stainless steel back in stock, currently with Eric pending forwarding them to Roger Comber.

F2 & F4 silencer: £144.00 (+VAT)

F Super silencer: £144.00 (+VAT)

F Super tail pipe: £62.46 (+VAT)

A new batch of 3-speeder front stub axle nut locking washers has just been produced.

Omega (Accralite) have confirmed that they could make Anzani pistons for us from an existing forging die so the price of these would be very similar to our current JAP and Matchless pistons. This is good news but is there any demand for these and if so what size(s) should be made? We have to commit to a minimum quantity of 20 of each finished size so it is very unlikely that we would be able to consider stocking more than one or two sizes (STD and one over-size?). It is important to let us know if you want to buy any. We will need to have five or six confirmed orders before we could consider proceeding.

We are also looking at the feasibility of having Blackburne pistons made so please get in touch if you are interested. I think there are slightly more Blackburne engined cars than Anzani being used than but I await your responses with interest.

I am keen that we should try to support owners of earlier cars as much as is practical, but Stephen Clark's new book shows just how few 2-speeders have survived (around 3%) compared with the very high survival rates for 3-speed twins and F types.
