Free entry to the Blyton Park Track Day - Monday 7 April

The donor will pay the Blyton Park track day fee of £150 for a limited number of persons under 30 years. The only conditions are that the entrant must take part as a driver in a Morgan three wheeler, old or new, and that he/she has had no previous competition experience.

This is a tremendous opportunity for a young person to have an enjoyable day out on a track with plenty of space, no traffic lights, speed cameras, oncoming traffic or other hazards. All that is required is a Morgan, a helmet and enthusiasm.
